



The Young and the Restless

“The Young and the Restless Screen Test” sponsored by CBS2 will take place in Los Angeles, CA, on Thursday, August 27th and Friday, August 28th, 2009.

One talented actress will be selected to appear in an episode of The Young and the Restless, participate in a photo shoot and be the cover model for The Young and the Restless “Restless Style” magazine.

WHO: Must be at least 18 years old on August 27, 2009 and able to perform the role of a woman who is 18-35, and eligible to work in the United States.

WHEN: Thursday, August 27 – Open Call starting at 9:00 am until 4:30 pm.
First round interviews for eligible actresses on an open call basis.

Friday, August 28 – Second Round and Screen Test, time TBA.
Participants advancing to second round and on-camera test with scene partner for finalists.

The show is broadcast weekdays (12:30-1:30 PM, ET); 11:00 AM-12:00 Noon, PT) on the CBS Television Network and is produced by Bell Dramatic Serial Company, in association with Sony Pictures Television.

Registration and Rules

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

You must be able to prove at the time of registration that:

- You are eligible to work full-time in the United States.
- You are at least 18 years old on August 27, 2009 and able to perform the role of a woman who is 18-35. If you were born after August 27, 1991 you are NOT eligible to participate.

You can not participate if you have any of the following agreements in place (written or oral) at this time:

- an agreement relating to the use of your name, voice and/or likeness;
- an exclusive acting contract; and/or
- any other contractual arrangement that, in Producer's sole discretion, would prohibit you from fully participating in the show.

You are ineligible if you, or any member of your immediate family and/or anyone living in your household, is an employee, officer, director, agent and/or representative of Sony Pictures Television, CBS Corporation, production personnel for the television program, participating television and radio stations, advertising agencies, corporate sponsors or any person or entity connected with the production, administration or judging of “The Young and the Restless Screen Test,” or any of the parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, agents or representatives of any of the foregoing entities.

THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

It is anticipated that registration will start no later than 9:00 a.m. on Thursday. Even if you are in line before 9:00 a.m., we cannot guarantee that you will be seen for an interview. Arrive early, but keep in mind that there is no guarantee that successful completion of the registration process will result in an interview.

You **MUST** bring the following:

- ID to show you are at least 18 years old.
- A recent photograph that we can keep. You can also bring a headshot, credits and a resume if you have them.
- A completed registration form (available at www.theyoungandtherestless.com).
- A signed release (available at www.theyoungandtherestless.com).

At the time of registration, you will be asked to verify your contact information. It is critical that you include accurate contact information. If we need you to return on Friday for the second round, we have to be able to reach you on Thursday night.

Release forms and registration forms should be downloaded, printed and completed in advance. Only limited supplies will be available at the time of registration.

After we determine your eligibility, you will be given a wristband (provided there are still some available).

It is currently anticipated that wristbands, or some other form of identification, will be handed out to those people who are eligible (or otherwise chosen by the producer) to participate in the process. In order to participate, you must receive a wristband from the production staff. Don't remove, trade, tamper with or accept a wristband from anyone other than the production staff. Disqualification could result.

No children will be allowed at the event venues.

Producers reserve the right to interview people out of order of their place in line. Due to space limitations, only one friend or family member in addition to the person being interviewed will be admitted into the venue where the event is taking place.

Please be courteous while waiting in line. Do not cut the line. Do not hold places in line excessively. If you cut the line you will be disqualified from the "The Young and the Restless Screen Test."

THE INTERVIEW PROCESS

OPEN CALL

If you meet the eligibility requirements during registration, and time permits, you will meet with a representative from the show and have the opportunity to present your qualifications. The Producers will use these interviews to determine who moves to the second round.

All participants who meet with representatives of the show will leave with script pages for a scene. However, receiving script pages does not guarantee that you will be invited to the second round. Should you receive an invitation to move to the second round, you will be expected to learn the material in time for Friday's second round.

It is very important that the Producers have a contact number where you can be reached Thursday night.

Please do not wear any clothing items that have designer names, sports teams, or any other logos or brand names, or bearing the name or likeness of a celebrity, living or dead. If you do wear such clothing, you may be required to remove it or turn it inside out or put on additional clothing to cover it.

SECOND ROUND

If the Producers invite you to return on Friday for the second round, you will be notified by a representative of the show on Thursday night. You will be given a call time and a location. Currently, we are planning on holding the second round at the CBS Radford Lot in Studio City starting at 9:00 am on Friday, but these plans are subject to change. Should the location change, you will be notified. Be on time and be prepared.

When you arrive for your second round, you must present proof of eligibility to work in the U.S. See the list of acceptable documents at www.theyoungandtherestless.com.

During the second round process you will read the scripted scene with a representative of the show. At the conclusion of the second round, the Producers will decide who will advance to the third and final rounds and receive a screen test with a cast member from the show.

If you are selected for a screen test, you must be available on Friday afternoon.

SCREEN TEST

If you are invited to return on Friday afternoon for a screen test, you will have the opportunity to be videotaped performing your scripted scene with a cast member from the show. The Producers will review all the screen tests and will make a final selection at time to be determined after the completion of the screen test.

The actress who is selected will receive an AFTRA contract guaranteeing her compensation as a principal performer in a dramatic serial for a single episode at the prevailing scale rate. The episode, tape date, character portrayed and the amount of dialogue are at the discretion of the producers. Additionally, the actress will participate in a photo shoot and be the cover model for the Young and the Restless "Restless Style" magazine. The actress must be available for the photo shoot and episode taping between October 1, 2009 and October 31, 2009 (exact dates to be determined and are at the sole discretion of the Producers. The actress will be responsible for any taxes on the compensation paid for their performance.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

All rules and procedures are subject to change at Producer's sole and absolute discretion.

In order to participate in "The Young and the Restless Screen Test," you will be required to fill out, sign and agree to all of the terms and conditions of Producer's required forms. Some of the forms will be available on our website at www.theyoungandtherestless.com. Your family and/or guests should also be prepared to sign releases concerning the possible taping and/or recording of their name, likeness, voice, conversation, etc. If you advance in the interview process, you may be required by the producer to fill out, sign and agree to all of the terms and conditions of additional forms, including a standard AFTRA contract.

All forms must be complete and truthful. Supplying false information or failing to reveal pertinent information may result in disqualification.

We reserve the right to disqualify and/or exclude, in our sole and absolute discretion, any individual from any portion of the "The Young and the Restless Screen Test" for any reason or for no reason at all, including without limitation, violation of any portion of these rules, or tampering with the entry process or the "The Young and the Restless Screen Test" process. We also reserve the right to change the rules and procedures at any time. Being chosen to interview at any level in the process does NOT ensure that you will be selected to continue to the next stage.

By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the Producers, which shall be final and binding. Your presence at "The Young and the Restless Screen Test," and the presence of your friends, family members, and anyone else accompanying you, constitutes your and their consent and agreement to the recording and use of your and their performance, appearance, name, voice and likeness for use in connection with any television program, motion picture, wireless/mobile device, or the Internet for all purposes (including advertising, marketing, promotion, merchandising and the exploitation of any and all ancillary and subsidiary rights), as the same may be edited, in all media now known or hereafter created, throughout the universe, in perpetuity for no compensation, unless otherwise required by law. If you and/or your friends, family members or anyone else accompanying you to "The Young and the Restless Screen Test" do not wish to be photographed, or do not agree with these terms, please do not attend the "The Young and the Restless Screen Test" and do not enter the venue where the interviews are taking place.

Your and/or their attendance at the event will be conclusively deemed to be a waiver of any and all claims for invasion of privacy, defamation, etc. All federal, state and local laws apply. "The Young and the Restless Screen Test" dates and locations are subject to change.

INFORMATION & FAQs

How long does the Open Call last?

The Open Call will tentatively last from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm on Thursday. Those who make it through the first round on Thursday may be asked to return on Friday for subsequent rounds at a time and location to be determined.

Will everyone in line have the opportunity to be interviewed on the event day?

This will depend on how many people show up for the event. Although we would love to interview everyone who is eligible, it may be impossible given time constraints. There is no guarantee that everyone who registers will be given the opportunity to be interviewed. If our time is running short, the producer may walk around the venue to pick out people to interview (regardless of how early they registered or their place in line) based on performing ability, look, style, personality and other factors, at Producer's sole discretion.

Are interviews by appointment or is it "cattle call" style?

The first round is not by appointment. All participants will appear at the same designated place and time as instructed by the Producers.

Do you charge for the interviews?

No. Interviews are free. Wristbands are free. You just have to meet our eligibility requirements and be physically present to get one. You cannot proceed in subsequent interviews without a wristband.

Some event locations charge for parking. The Producers have no control over rates and do not share in the revenue.

Where do I get the release form and where do I send it once it has been completed?

You can obtain the release form from our website at www.theyoungandtherestless.com. You should bring the SIGNED release form (and your ID) with you and make sure that it is filled out and signed BEFORE you arrive at the event venue, as only a limited number of forms will be available at the event venue.

Can I bring my friends or family members to the event?

People who are participating in the process may bring ONLY ONE FRIEND OR FAMILY MEMBER with them into the interior of the event venue.

I am a member of AFTRA. Can I still participate?

Yes, but you must be a member in good standing. We can not hire AFTRA members who are behind on their dues or other payments.

If I have a manager for anything entertainment-related or a contract for my performing services, can I still participate?

You can not participate if you have any of the following agreements in place (written or oral) at this time:

- an agreement relating to the use of your name, voice and/or likeness;
- an exclusive acting contract; and/or
- any other contractual arrangement that, in Producer's sole discretion, would prohibit you from fully participating in the show.

What can I bring with me to the event?

The list below is not exhaustive and even if an item is listed below, the producers and security reserve the right to ask you to remove any such items from the venue. Any items you bring are your responsibility and all bags are subject to search:

- Bottled water
- Cell phones
- Digital or still cameras (no video cameras)
- Small bags

What should I NOT bring with me to the event?

The list of prohibited items below is not exhaustive and even if an item is not listed below, the Producers and security reserve the right to ask you to remove any such item from the venue. People in possession of prohibited items will be denied admission to the line and to the venue, and may be subject to immediate disqualification. All bags are subject to search.

- Alcoholic beverages
- Animals other than service animals
- Cans or bottles other than bottled water
- Fireworks
- Folding chairs
- Hair dryers
- Children
- Illegal drugs
- Lawn chairs or chaise lounges
- Luggage / suitcases
- Molded plastic chairs
- Video cameras or camcorders of any kind
- Weapons of any kind (including pocket knives, "army knives" or Swiss Army type knives, and all swords)
- Musical instruments
