

LET'S MAKE A DEAL CONTESTANT SEARCH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND RULES

Please note: the following eligibility requirements and terms must be met in order to proceed with the application process for LET'S MAKE A DEAL CONTESTANT SEARCH (the "Contestant Search").

1. Only one application per person.
2. There will be open casting calls in selected markets beginning February 2, 2010 through February 14, 2010 ("Open Casting Calls"). Each applicant will be interviewed on camera for approximately thirty (30) seconds answering the question "Why do you want to be a contestant on LET'S MAKE A DEAL?" (see paragraph 10 below for judging criteria). This question may change from time to time at the sole discretion of the producers of LET'S MAKE A DEAL ("Producers").
3. You must be 18 years of age or older at the time of application.
4. You must be a legal resident of the United States and live in the United States as of the date you submit your application and continuing through the dates of travel to Los Angeles, CA if you are selected as a semi-finalist.
5. You may not now be a candidate for public office, and if selected to be a contestant, you must agree not to become a candidate for public office until after the initial broadcast of the program in which you appear.
6. You may not have been a contestant on LET'S MAKE A DEAL within the last three (3) years. Specifically:
 - a. You have not taped an appearance as a contestant or participant on any other television game show which has been (or may be) aired within one (1) year of your appearance on this Program.
 - b. You have not been a contestant on more than four (4) other television game shows of any type with ten (10) years of the taping of your appearance for the Program.
7. Employees, officers, directors and agents of CBS Corporation, CBS Broadcasting Inc., 3 Doors Productions, Inc., or FremantleMedia North America, Inc. (and any parent, subsidiary, or affiliate of any of the foregoing), and local and national sponsors of LET'S MAKE A DEAL and/or of any of their respective licensees, assigns, partners, parents, subsidiary, or affiliated companies and the immediate family (spouse, mother, father, sister, brother, daughter or son, regardless of where they live) or members of their same households (whether related or not) of such employees, officers, directors and agents are not eligible to be participants in the Contestant Search or participate in the application process.
8. Two (2) semi-finalists will be selected from each Open Casting Call. Each semi-finalist will receive a trip to Los Angeles, a ticket to attend the filming of an episode of LET'S MAKE A DEAL and the opportunity to be called to play LET'S MAKE A DEAL ("Grand Prize Winner"). The Producers will further interview each group of the two (2) semi-finalists while in Los Angeles and select a Grand Prize Winner from each group of two (2) based on their answers

during that interview. The Prize for each semi-finalist shall consist of roundtrip coach airfare for one (1) person from the airport closest to the participating contestant search market to Los Angeles, two nights standard hotel accommodations (room and tax only) in Los Angeles, transportation to and from the set for LET'S MAKE A DEAL and the opportunity to be selected as a contestant in an episode of LET'S MAKE A DEAL. (Approximate value is \$1,200, depending upon the cost of air travel). Each Grand Prize Winner will be named during the filming of the episode they attend and asked to participate as a contestant in that episode. Each semi-finalist winner is responsible for the full cost of transportation to and from the airport in the departure and arrival city and all taxes related to transportation. Prize does not include items not specified, such as travel insurance, hotel room service, parking fees, laundry service, food, alcoholic beverages, merchandise, or souvenirs, etc. Each Grand Prize Winner also will be responsible for any taxes related to prizes won as a result of their participation as a contestant in an episode of LET'S MAKE A DEAL, if any.

9. By accepting the prize, you acknowledge that you are not guaranteed to receive a prize of monetary value on LET'S MAKE A DEAL or the opportunity to come on stage.

10. The applicant's responses to the questions posed during the Contestant Search and during the interviews in Los Angeles will be judged by personnel from LET'S MAKE A DEAL based on the following criteria: clarity of answer, personality, and enthusiasm.

11. If you are selected by the Producers as a semi-finalist, you must be willing to travel to Los Angeles, California between March 22, 2010 and May 31, 2010 (as scheduled by the Producers) on the same dates as the other semi-finalist chosen from the Contestant Search in your area. If you are unable to travel to Los Angeles on the same dates as the other semi-finalist from your area, you will forfeit the prize and the opportunity to be a participant in an episode of LET'S MAKE A DEAL, and an alternate semi-finalist may be chosen by Producers, in their sole discretion, from the Contestant Search in your area. You also authorize the Producers to conduct civil, criminal, financial, driver-history and any other type of background checks deemed necessary by the Producers. All dates and locations listed in these eligibility requirements and in the application form are subject to change in the Producers' sole discretion, without notice. Payment of all federal, state, and local taxes are the sole responsibility of winner, and winner may receive an IRS Form 1099 or equivalent from the Producers.

12. If you are chosen to be a semi-finalist, Producers shall not be responsible for making any necessary arrangements with your employer and family in anticipation of your absence from home and your job.

13. The Producers reserve the right to change any of the rules, eligibility requirements and terms, including the terms of any prizes to be awarded at any time without notice. CBS and the Producers are not responsible for technical or other failures, errors or tape loss of any kind, or failed, incomplete, garbled or damaged tapes or materials, or any other error or malfunction, or late, lost, illegible or misdirected entries. Entry materials that have been tampered with or altered are void. If CBS and the Producers determine, in their sole discretion, that technical difficulties compromise the integrity of any Contestant Search, CBS and the Producers reserve the right to void the entries at issue and/or terminate the Contestant Search. If the Contestant Search is

terminated due to tampering or technical difficulties prior to its expiration date, notice will be posted at www.wwjtv.com.

14. The Producers reserve the right to add, cancel and/or substitute other cities for the Contestant Search.

15. Completed applications must be submitted at the casting call. Applications MUST be written clearly or typed. Complete applications that are sent to Producers shall consist of the following: Completed Participant Application (including a Release and Waiver signed by you) and a videotape recorded at the Contestant Search. Applications will only be considered if they are complete.

DEADLINE: ALL COMPLETED SUBMISSIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY MIDNIGHT PACIFIC STANDARD TIME, FEBRUARY 14, 2010.

16. All materials (including videotape and application) will be retained by the Producers and become the property of the Producers and will not be returned to you whether or not you are selected as a participant. Any expenses you incur during the application process including travel costs and materials preparation, etc. are your sole responsibility. The Producers will not reimburse you for these expenses. All decisions of the Producers are final and absolute and not subject to inquiry or appeal.

17. Unfortunately, we will not be able to verify that we have received your application. The Producers are not responsible for lost or damaged applications.

18. If you are selected as a semi-finalist, you will be notified by CBS Television Stations by phone and/or email.

19. We reserve the right to make changes to the application and Contestant Search schedule.

20. The Producers reserve the right to modify the manner in which the Contestant Search is conducted.

PRODUCERS AND NETWORK RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CHANGE, ADD TO, DELETE FROM, MODIFY OR AMEND THESE RULES AT THEIR SOLE DISCRETION.
